
Health and Safety Protocol



To return safety together and follow San Francisco Unified School District (SFUSD) and San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH), Au Co Vietnamese Cultural Center **require students**, **families and staff** must follow a few important requirements for you and your child related to Covid-19 prevention in all the center's programs and activities.

- Screen for any Covid related symptoms before coming to the center and stay home if you feel sick.
- Wear a mask at all times (regardless of whether you are vaccinated or not) when indoors at the center unless you are eating or drinking outdoors and recommend keeping social distance at least 6ft from others.
- Students with medical conditions who cannot mask are required to provide medical documentation and can be exempt.

VENTILATION



- Doors and windows will remain open to maximize air ventilation when health and safety allow.

CLEANING AND DISINFECTION

- Students are required to wash or sanitize hands before and after using shared supplies, playing outdoors, eating, and after using the bathroom.
- Cleaning and disinfecting supplies will be available for each classroom.
- Personal Protect Equipment (PPE) will be provided at the center.
- Staff will clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces such as door handles, tables, desks, etc.

IF SOMEONE GETS SICK

- Students, families, or staff who report testing positive for COVID-19 must isolate at home for at least 10 days. After 10 days, you can return to the center with a negative Covid 19 test and free from Covid symptoms. For the community health and safety, please tell and update the center staff your Covid status. We are here to help.
- Any vaccinated students, families or staff who are identified as a close contact can continue to come to the center with a negative Covid-19 within 7 days and free from Covid symptoms.
- Any unvaccinated students, families or staff who are identified as a close contact might be quarantined at home for at least 10 days Or You can continue to come to the center with a negative Covid-19 within 7 days and free from Covid symptoms.

SELF-SCREENING QUESTIONS

If NO to <u>all</u> questions: Your child may go to school.

If YES to <u>any</u> question: Your child must stay home.

Call your school and provide the reason for your child's absence.

- Has your child tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 10 days?
- Has your child been in close contact with anyone with COVID-19 within the past 14 days?
- Is your child feeling ill or had any of the following symptoms within the past 10 days?
 - Fever greater than 100.4F/38C
 - Chills
 - Cough
 - Sore Throat
 - Shortness of Breath
 - Headache
 - Nausea/Vomiting
 - Diarrhea
 - Not being able to taste or smell, or saying that things taste or smell differently
